The Toonie

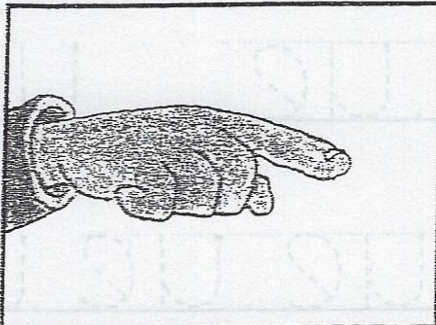
