### Materials:

- White sheet of cardstock paper
- 3 different sized circle lids (small, medium, large)
- Orange and yellow crayon
- Yellow paint
- Plastic fork

### Instructions:

- 1. Trace circles onto your white paper making sure to use several different sizes to represent the different sizes of stars.
- 2. Color each circle yellow and orange.
- 3. Use the yellow paint and a plastic fork to paint the rays of light around each star and let it dry.



# **Sunflower Handprint Craft**

#### Materials:

- Yellow Foam Sheets or yellow construction paper
- Something to trace with pen, pencil, etc.
- A Tacky Glue that dries clear
- Scissors
- Sunflower Seeds
- Wooden Dowels (optional)
- Green Floral Tape (optional)
- Vase or Jug to display the sunflowers in (optional)

Instructions:

- 1. Using foam sheets or construction paper, trace your hand 6-8 times. Leave an approximately 3-inch square without a handprint for the circle that will go into the middle of the sunflower
- 2. Cut the handprints and your 3-inch circle out of the foam / construction paper.
- 3. Begin to fan them around, with at least 3 on the first layer, adding more handprints on top for more dimension
- 4. Once you are satisfied with the shape of the handprints, glue them together.
- 5. Glue the circle you have cut out onto the center of the handprints
- 6. Glue sunflower seeds onto the 3-inch circle.
- 7. If you are making the stem, while you wait on the glue to dry, wrap the wooden dowels with green floral tape or an alternative you have at home.
  - a. If you do not have wooden dowels or green tape look around your house and see what you could use instead.
- 8. Repeat this process until you have a bouquet of flowers to fill your vase.
