Build a word with the letters.</p>	<p>Make a Book! Staple or fold pages together to make a book. Use pictures and words to tell a story.</p>	<p>Puzzle it! Write out letters or words on a piece of paper. Cut the paper into 10 to 20 random pieces. Put the puzzle together.</p>	<p>Make a comic! Divide a piece of paper into six rectangles. In each rectangle draw a picture and speech bubbles.</p>

Draw a picture and write a word for each letter in the alphabet.</p>	<p>Q-tip Paint! Use Q-tips and paint to make letters or words.</p>	<p>Sticker it! Use small stickers to make letters or words.</p>
